In **thoracic surgery** I managed anesthesia for patients undergoing intra-thoracic and mediastinal procedures mostly performed for oncologic and infectious purposes as well as traumatic and correction of congenital chest malformations. I improved my skills and became more confident with the standard techniques as well as the blended anesthesia [combination of central blocks (epidural, paravertebral and intercostal) with general anesthesia].

In **CathLabs** I performed anesthesia and conscious sedation for a very large range of cardiologic procedures in patients affected by severe cardiac congenital diseases. I improved my skills in intraoperative TOE assessment of patients undergoing cardiac surgery and/or CathLab procedures.

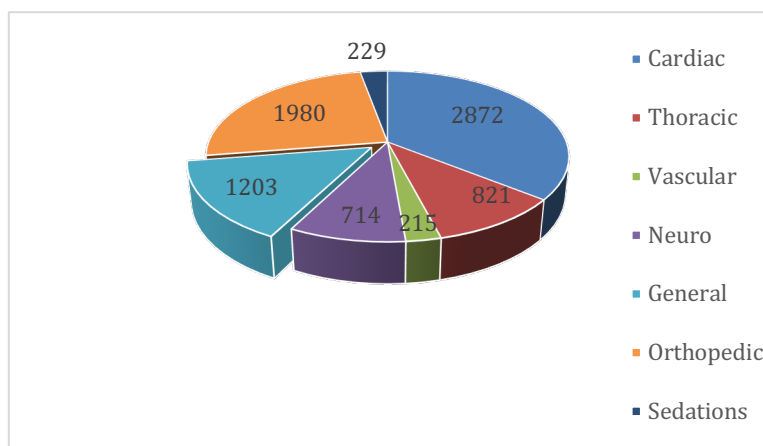
